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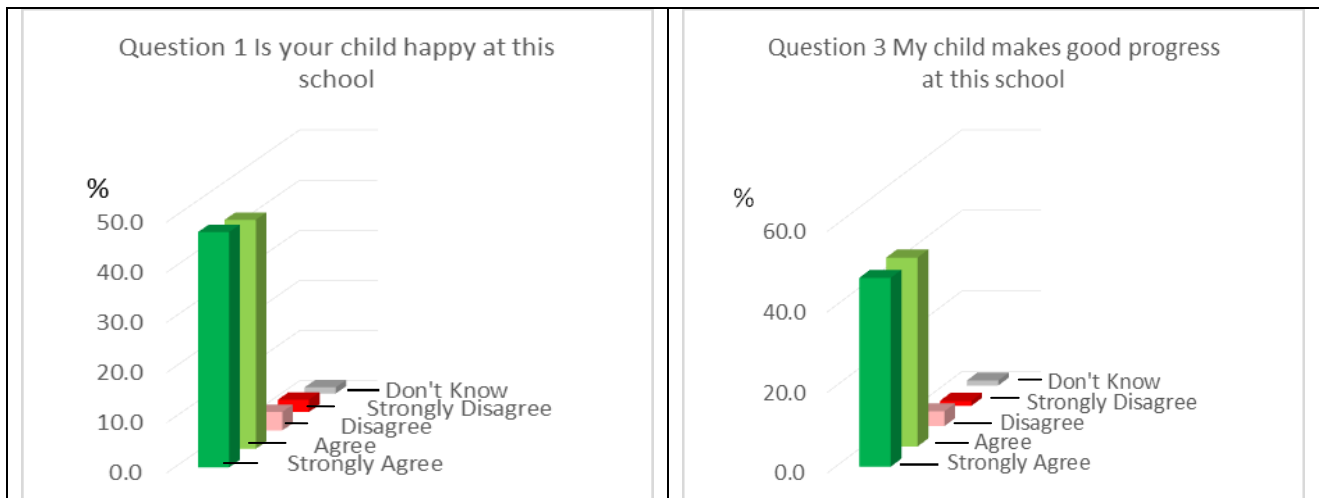

As you may remember at parents' evening, in the Autumn Term, members of the Governing Body approached many of you to complete a questionnaire based on Ofsted's Parent View survey.

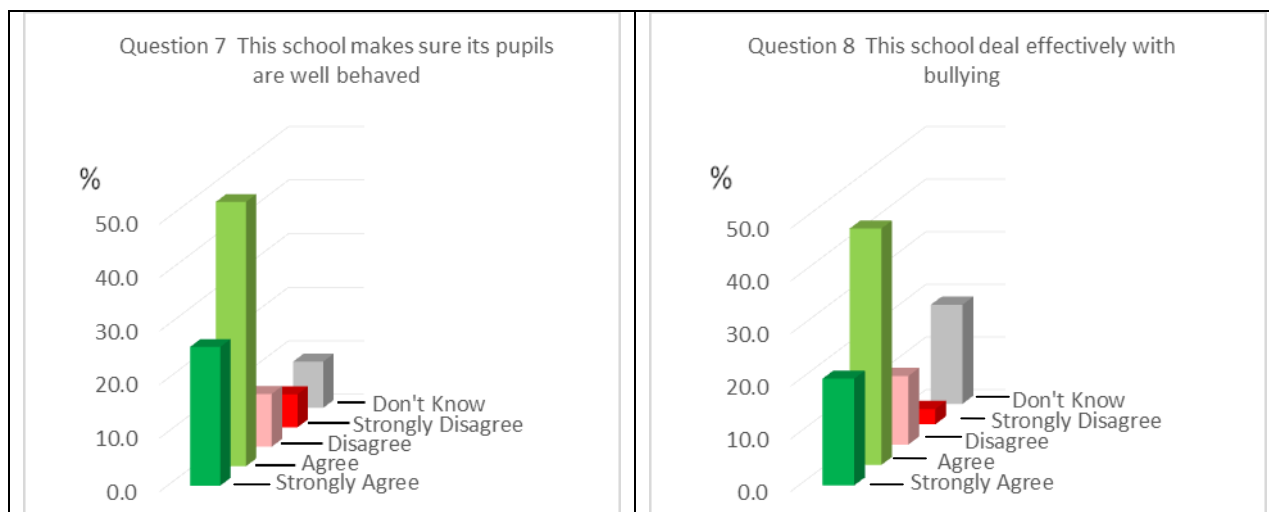
Firstly, the governing body would like to thank all those that completed the form as your feedback is very important to us. Over the two parents' evenings we managed to collect over 80 completed forms. This number was far greater than we had anticipated and therefore provides us with a very balanced outcome of our parents' views and opinions of our school. Especially if you consider a lot of parents completing the form have more than one child at the school.

Here are some of the results:



The results shown in the two graphs above indicate to the governing body and the senior leadership team that almost 90% of parents agree or strongly agree that their child(ren) are happy at our school and that they make good progress. A similar result was seen for many of the other questions on the survey. Therefore, this gives a very positive message for us all to take away.

However, we did feel that the outcome for a couple of other questions required our consideration.



These results indicate to us that the vast majority of parents agreed or strongly agreed with these questions. However, some parents feel that behaviour at the school needs to be improved and that a number of parents are not aware of the schools policies on behaviour and bullying, shown by the increased number of 'Don't Know' replies. We have therefore been considering the best way to approach and improve these aspects highlighted.

The senior leadership team has recently reiterated the schools' policy on acceptable behaviour in school to the children. Any misunderstandings that did arise due to this action have since been clarified. We would like to ensure all parents are fully aware of the Behaviour Policy.
